RECYCLING PROJECT CHALLENGE

As we learned in *One Plastic Bag* by Miranda Paul, plastic trash was causing an issue in Isatou Cessay's Gambian village. Isatou and the women of Njau solved this problem through hard work and creativity.

This project challenge is designed to celebrate their accomplishments!

Who: K-12 students residing in Hampton Township (*Optional - Not a school requirement!*)

What: Design and create a useful new product or invention from unwanted, recyclable materials found in your home. Constructed with these household recyclable materials, a final project will be a functional product of benefit to people.

How:

1. Entries must be created from clean recyclable materials found around the home.
2. **DO NOT** purchase any materials to construct your project.
(Glue and/or any adhesive material may be purchased for use in the project.)
3. One project entry per family. ****If families have siblings enrolled in multiple HTSD buildings, they may: a) choose a building to submit their entry, or b) submit a different project entry to each students' home building.**** *HOA students may submit entries to their home school and HHS students may submit entries at the Hampton Community Library.*
4. Entries must be within the maximum dimensions of 2 feet long, 2 feet high, and 2 feet wide.
5. Complete the attached form and submit it with your entry to your school's library (Hampton Community Library for HHS students submissions) by the deadline.

When: The deadline for submissions is **Friday, April 9, 2021.**

Judging: Entries will be judged on originality, practicality, creativity, and overall design. One winning project from each building will be announced on Friday, April 23rd. The winner will receive a \$25 gift card and be featured in a school or HTSD publication.
